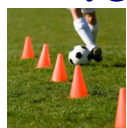

Ground Marshall (at Games)

It is really important that each team has a parent or 2 who can regularly have the role of Ground Marshall at games. A Ground Marshall helps with giving information and directions. A Ground Marshall welcomes and supports the Referee. They manage the group of people watching the game. A Ground Marshall speaks with the referee and assists with duties e.g. presents match card and balls, monitors honour lines on the pitch and spectator behavior. Alcohol is not to be consumed on the sidelines of any games.
